



From Shrove Tuesday to Easter Day there is an action for you to do on six days in each week of Lent. Lent is 40 days long to match the amount of time that Jesus spent in the wilderness. Sundays are not counted because every Sunday is a reminder of Easter Day.

The actions are quite simple. What makes them challenging is how you do them and, if we all do them, then the world really could become the place that God wants it to be: one person at a time, one action at a time.
